Thoughts From Ted



Recently I surprised (maybe even scared) a number of the people I work with. What did I do that surprised them so much? I committed what my mother used to call "a neat-ness." By that she meant that something that normally was, at best, disorganized or, at worst, a complete mess, was straightened out.

That's what happened in my office. Normally my desk is full of stacks of paper, random items from people, the odd book or three, and folders of meeting minutes and records. Frankly, most of the time, it is simply a mess. But then I committed "a neat-ness." Old papers were thrown away or a few of them filed. Extra kids toys were returned to their place. Borrowed books were returned to their owners. Desk surfaces that hadn't been seen in a long time were visible and could be cleaned themselves.

And every person I worked with who came into my office and saw it said something along the lines of "I don't even recognize it anymore!" This was my "neat-ness."

But as I put things back in order, I found myself wondering how it happened. I didn't intend for it to get that messy or leave any of it there over the months on purpose. I really didn't notice that it was getting messier and messier. But it did.

Which made it a good reminder that even in the life of the church, things can get messy—can get out of control—and we don't even really notice. A little repair in the church gets put off. Why would we support that new mission—we've got our things to support. We'll check on our neighboring church when we have the time. And before we know it the "desk" of our church is covered with junk that covers up where Christ might normally be found.

As we head into spring and past Easter, may we keep the "desks" of our lives clear of anything that might cover up what Jesus is calling us to do. And who knows what surprises we might find?!


Get Loaded!

- ...Christian Education reported about the "Cupcake Wars" event on March 17 and that a Confirmation Class will be held on April 27 with the plan to receive the confirmands on May 12.
- ...noted Pastor will be helping out by preaching April 21 in Brooklyn, Michigan.
- ...noted the beginning of work along Adams Street in removing dead and overgrown hedge.
- ...heard about the sump pump repairs and leaks out front. Both are being worked on.
- ...adjourned with prayer at about 7:35 PM.

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

The Gooding Family Memorial Scholarship—The Gooding family, comprising of Perry L. & Lillian Gooding, Dale P. Gooding, & Margaret L. Gooding, valued the desire of young people to achieve a higher degree of education. To support these efforts and specifically for the members of First Presbyterian Church, the Gooding family has established a scholarship to help young people pay for their college education, trade and vocational schooling, and other education which obtains degrees or certification.

Grace Fisher Endowed Scholarship—The Grace Fisher Scholarship is an endowed scholarship, which was established by the Women's Association of the First Presbyterian Church of Saginaw, MI to honor Grace Fisher, the wife of Henry Fisher D.D. who served the congregation from 1920 to 1957 as pastor. Grace Fisher exhibited a constant effort to build the Women's Association and was faithfully devoted to its aims.

Muriel Lakey Scholarship Available—This scholarship is provided by the family of Muriel Lakey, and is available to active members of First Church who are pursuing post-high school education at a 2- or 4-year college or university, at a vocational or trade school, or at a theological seminary. The scholarship is renewable and is not limited to undergraduate study or to any particular institution. The scholarship will be awarded to eligible candidates on the basis of their participation in the church's work and worship and financial need.
